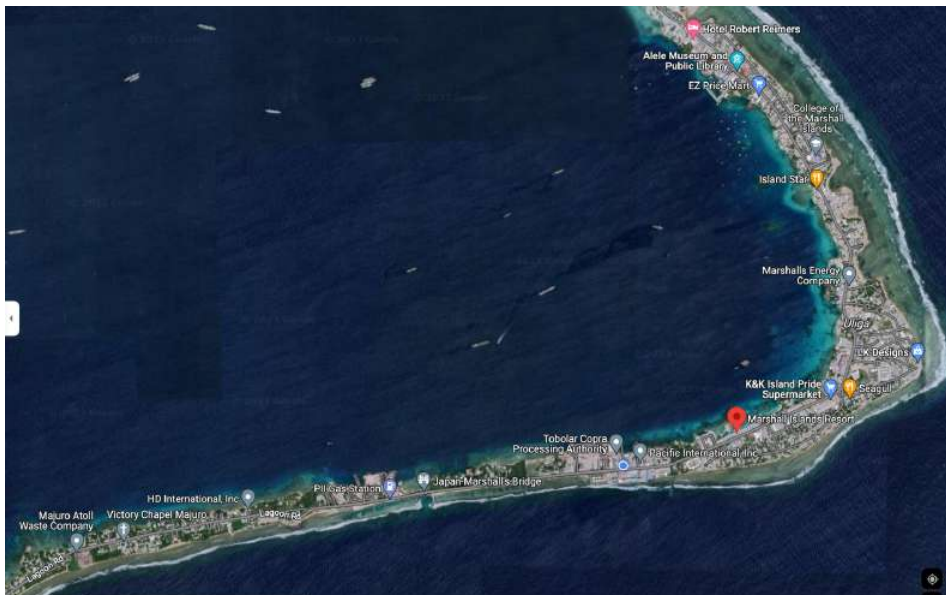

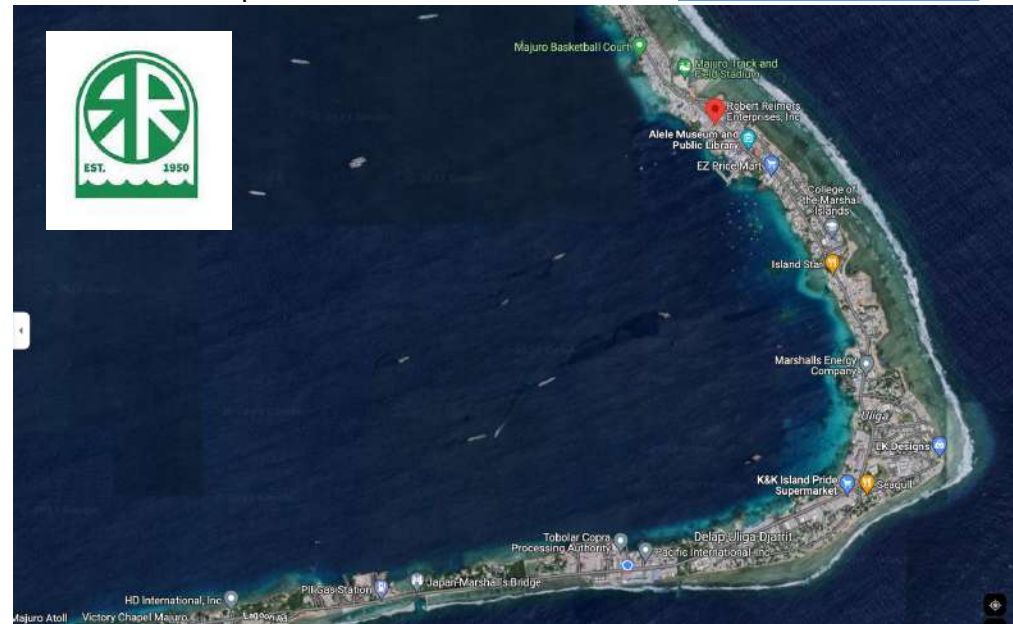

IOKWE *Majuro* HISTORICAL TOUR

Jikin Kepeep En
This site preserves the story of a very strong giant whose name was Tōtōlōpāān. Tōtōlōpāān was the youngest brother of Jemalut and the famous trickster Letao. His strength was proven when he threw rocks north to Aur Atoll causing the land to break into islets and almost sank. At one point, he threw rocks from Kūmōōr in Ajeltake to Aur Atoll sixty miles NW. The sand dunes at Ajeltake mark the spot where Tōtōlōpāān pushed up the bank when he planted his feet.

Jikin Tekjek Wa En
This site preserves the story of where the great carver carved his outrigger canoes. Legend has it that the canoe for Majuro's (rooj) was carved at this site was located a Noot (a shell containing ground water which was used as a wash) and Lanmojanjan (four pieces of wood used at the end of the canoe hull to hold it together) were buried. All of these items were buried in the recent past, they could be found by digging up the area where they were buried. They were originally buried in a depression on the land.

Bokjanwut
This site preserves the story of a rat mother, a rat woman, and her son Bokjanwut. Bokjanwut resided in the northern end of Majuro. Bokjanwut did not want to visit the southern end of Majuro. Bokjanwut disobeyed his mother's request and played the way to the south end, where he met rooj Jemalut. They challenged rooj Jemalut to a canoe race, which he subsequently won. Next, rooj Jemalut required, "Who are you with?" Bokjanwut then replied, "I am with my mother." The rooj subsequently expressed his desire to meet Likjik. After the incident, Bokjanwut hurried home and informed his mother. The mother said, "See, I told you not to go south, how will I face the people when I'm a rat?" She told him to walk on her so that she could transform into a woman. She turned from a rat to a stunning beautiful woman after her son walked on her.
